SCHOLARSHIPS¹

The scholarship application period for Fresno State normally starts **October 1** and ends on **March 2**. In order to be considered for a Fresno State scholarship, students must be a continuing student or a new student who has applied for admission. Most of the scholarships listed in our directory only require you to complete our general scholarship application. However, some apply-to scholarships require additional information from you to determine your eligibility.
